Readings for the Second Sunday of Lent

First Reading: Gn 12:1-4

The LORD said to Abram: "Go forth from the land of your kinsfolk and from your father's house to a land that I will show you. "I will make of you a great nation, and I will bless you; I will make your name great, so that you will be a blessing. I will bless those who bless you and curse those who curse you. All the communities of the earth shall find blessing in you." Abram went as the LORD directed him.

Second Reading: 2 Tm 1:8b-10

Beloved: Bear your share of hardship for the gospel with the strength that comes from God. He saved us and called us to a holy life, not according to our works but according to his own design and the grace bestowed on us in Christ Jesus before time began, but now made manifest through the appearance of our savior Christ Jesus, who destroyed death and brought life and immortality to light through the gospel.

Gospel: Mt 17:1-9

Jesus took Peter, James, and John his brother, and led them up a high mountain by themselves. And he was transfigured before them; his face shone like the sun and his clothes became white as light. And behold, Moses and Elijah appeared to them, conversing with him. Then Peter said to Jesus in reply, "Lord, it is good that we are here. If you wish, I will make three tents here, one for you, one for Moses, and one for Elijah." While he was still speaking, behold, a bright cloud cast a shadow over them, then from the cloud came a voice that said, "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased; listen to him." When the disciples heard this, they fell prostrate and were very much afraid. But Jesus came and touched them, saying, "Rise, and do not be afraid." And when the disciples raised their eyes, they saw no one else but Jesus alone. As they were coming down from the mountain, Jesus charged them, "Do not tell the vision to anyone until the Son of Man has been raised from the dead."

Profession of Faith:

I believe in one God, the Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible. I believe in one Lord Jesus Christ, the Only Begotten Son of God, born of the Father before all ages. God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, consubstantial with the Father; through him all things were made. For us men and for our salvation he came down from heaven,

and by the Holy Spirit was incarnate of the Virgin Mary, and became man.

For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate, he suffered death and was buried, and rose again on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead and his kingdom will have no end. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son, who with the Father and the Son is adored and glorified, who has spoken through the prophets. I believe in one, holy, catholic and apostolic Church. I confess one Baptism for the forgiveness of sins and I look forward to the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come. Amen.

Administrator's Note

My Dear Friends,

It's important to remember the following: *Jesus does not see us for what we are, He sees us for what we can become.* So, the question for us is "what can we become in the eyes of God? It seems at times that the world is changing the Church of God, more so, than the Church is changing the world. Let's think about that for a minute. I believe it's time that "we" the Church get back to work on the mission at hand. The mission of becoming what the Lord wants us to become in His eyes, and not of the world.

In last week's Gospel, Jesus was led to the desert by the Spirit to be tempted for forty days and for forty nights, but never sinned. The image of Jesus going into the desert should be our image of encountering the devil and reflecting upon our own weaknesses as human beings to change the way we think, speak, and act to one another and especially to our Lord. Our encounter should be one of self examination, penance, and reconciliation. But, our story should not end in the desert. *"If we are faithless, He remains faithful."* (2 Timothy 2:13)

My dear friends, there is a simple mathematical equation to follow in Christianity. The equation is - faith equals what we can become. I have come to realize recently that faith is like a muscle. The more you use it the stronger it becomes. But the less you use it the weaker it becomes. Faith grows stronger through testing. So, please remember the next time we are praying together or alone and we ask the Lord for faith, we must realize and not be surprised faith comes through trials and testing. It's how our faith grows and we BECOME closer to our Lord. In the first chapter of James, it says, *"Dear brothers and sisters, when trouble of any kind comes your way, consider it an opportunity for great joy. For when you know your faith is tested, your endurance has a chance to grow."*

In today's Gospel, we hear *"This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased; listen to him."* *When the disciples heard this, they fell prostrate and were very much afraid. But Jesus came and touched them, saying, "Rise, and do not be afraid." And when the disciples raised their eyes,...*

It's those words by Jesus, *"Rise, and do not be afraid."* that gives me hope on what we can become in the eyes of God. It's those words that fill my heart with the promise from our Lord that we all can change and this is not the end. We can become who our Lord wants us to be even if we don't see it or at times believe it.

Remember, faith equals who we can become. *"Rise, and do not be afraid."*

May this lenten season be one of an awakening,

Queridos amigos,

Es importante recordar lo siguiente: *Jesús no nos ve por lo que somos, nos ve por lo que podemos llegar a ser.* Entonces, la pregunta para nosotros es "¿qué podemos llegar a ser a los ojos de Dios? A veces parece que el mundo está cambiando la Iglesia de Dios, más de lo que la Iglesia está cambiando el mundo. Pensemos en eso por un minuto. Creo que es hora de que "nosotros", la Iglesia, volvamos a trabajar en la misión que tenemos entre manos. La misión de convertirnos en lo que el Señor quiere que seamos en sus ojos, y no del mundo.

En el Evangelio de la semana pasada, Jesús fue llevado al desierto por el Espíritu para ser tentado durante cuarenta días y cuarenta noches, pero nunca pecó. La imagen de Jesús yendo al desierto debería ser nuestra imagen de encuentro con el diablo y de reflexión sobre nuestras propias debilidades como seres humanos para cambiar nuestra forma de pensar, hablar y actuar con los demás y especialmente con nuestro Señor. Nuestro encuentro debe ser un examen de conciencia, penitencia y reconciliación. Pero nuestra historia no debe terminar en el desierto. *"Si somos infieles, Él permanece fiel"*. (2 Timoteo 2:13)

Queridos amigos, hay una sencilla ecuación matemática a seguir en el cristianismo. La ecuación es: la fe es igual a lo que podemos llegar a ser. Recientemente me he dado cuenta de que la fe es como un músculo. Cuanto más lo usas, más fuerte se hace. Pero cuanto menos la usas, más se debilita. La fe se fortalece con la prueba. Así que, por favor recuerden la próxima vez que estemos orando juntos o solos y le pidamos fe al Señor, debemos darnos cuenta y no sorprendernos de que la fe viene a través de las pruebas. Así es como crece nuestra fe y NOS ACERCAMOS más a nuestro Señor. En el primer capítulo de Santiago, dice: *"Queridos hermanos y hermanas, cuando os sobrevengan dificultades de cualquier clase, consideradlas ocasión de gran gozo. Porque cuando sabéis que vuestra fe es puesta a prueba, vuestra resistencia tiene la oportunidad de crecer"*.

En el Evangelio de hoy, oímos: *"Este es mi Hijo amado, en quien tengo complacencia; escuchadle"*. *Al oír esto, los discípulos se postraron y tuvieron mucho miedo. Pero Jesús se acercó y los tocó, diciendo: "Levántense y no teman". Y cuando los discípulos levantaron los ojos,...*

Son esas palabras de Jesús, *"Levántense y no teman"*, las que me dan esperanza sobre lo que podemos llegar a ser en los ojos de Dios. Son esas palabras las que llenan mi corazón con la promesa de nuestro Señor de que todos podemos cambiar y que este no es el final. Podemos llegar a ser lo que nuestro Señor quiere que seamos aunque no lo veamos o a veces no lo creamos.

Recuerda, la fe es igual a lo que podemos llegar a ser. *"Levántense y no temas"*.

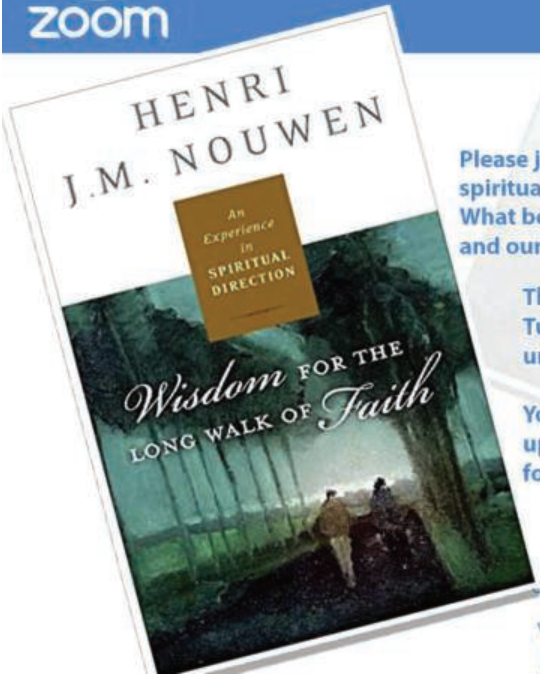

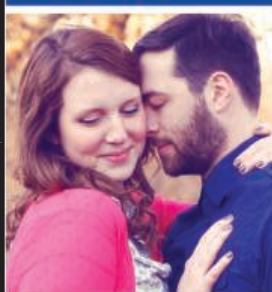
