Readings for Fifth Sunday of Easter

First Reading: Acts 6:1-7

As the number of disciples continued to grow, the Hellenists complained against the Hebrews because their widows were being neglected in the daily distribution. So the Twelve called together the community of the disciples and said, “ It is not right for us to neglect the word of God to serve at table. Brothers, select from among you seven reputable men, filled with the Spirit and wisdom, whom we shall appoint to this task, whereas we shall devote ourselves to prayer and to the ministry of the word.” The proposal was acceptable to the whole community, so they chose Stephen, a man filled with faith and the Holy Spirit, also Philip, Prochorus, Nicanor, Timon, Parmenas, and Nicholas of Antioch, a convert to Judaism. They presented these men to the apostles who prayed and laid hands on them. The word of God continued to spread, and the number of the disciples in Jerusalem increased greatly; even a large group of priests were becoming obedient to the faith.

Gospel: Jn 14:1-12

And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come back again and take you to myself, so that where I am you also may be. Where I am going you know the way." Thomas said to him, "Master, we do not know where you are going; how can we know the way?" Jesus said to him, I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me. If you know me, then you will also know my Father. From now on you do know him and have seen him." Philip said to him, "Master, show us the Father, and that will be enough for us. " Jesus said to him, "Have I been with you for so long a time and you still do not know me, Philip? Whoever has seen me has seen the Father. How can you say, 'Show us the Father'? Amen, amen, I say to you, whoever believes in me will do the works that I do, and will do greater ones than these because I am going to the Father."

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son, who with the Father and the Son is adored and glorified, who has spoken through the prophets. I believe in one, holy, catholic and apostolic Church. I confess one Baptism for the forgiveness of sins and I look forward to the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come. Amen.

Administrator's Note

My Dear Friends,

For me this is the definition of a true friendship. A true friend is someone that's always going to tell you the truth, even when it hurts. A true friend is someone that cries with you, and fights next to you. A true friend is someone that helps you be not so serious, but is serious on how you handle your life. A true friend is someone that knows your business, but never tells it. And finally, a true friend is someone that will always love you, even when you don't love yourself. Why is it that we have the tendency not to look at Jesus as a true friend?

In last week's bulletin, I quoted Diana Ross, from her smash hit The Theme from Mahogany. The question that I posed came from the opening line, "*Do you know?*" Well, today, I'd like to begin with this question, "*You Still Don't Know Me?*"

Have we ever encountered a moment in our lives, in which we have known someone for a very long time, let's say a very close friend, and then out of the blue, they ask a question or make a statement that leaves you scratching your head. My dear friends, we are challenged to look at our lives and find out if we truly know who Jesus Christ is in our lives. If we are having problems finding out "*Who we are*" then we must be having problems trying to figure out "*What is truly our purpose*" in life. Somebody might say, I think you are way off Father. But, my response is very simple, those who call themselves Christians have an obligation to serve and be called disciples and to find out who they are in the "*eyes of God.*" We are all sinners, and its redemptions which gives us our salvation.

DEI ET APOSTOLICAE SEDIS GRATIA
EPISCOPUS CAMDENSIS

DECREE REGARDING PARISH MASS SCHEDULES
IN THE DIOCESE OF CAMDEN


In order to better address the declining number of priests in the presbyterate of the Diocese of Camden, along with the decline in Mass attendance, and having taken counsel with both the Presbyteral Council and the Vicars Forane, in exercising vigilance over the celebration of the sacraments, in accord with canon 392 §2 of the Code of Canon Law, in order that the pastoral effort regarding the celebration of Mass may be more effective for the building up of the ecclesiastical community and so as to not overburden the priests of the diocese, allowing them to more adequately fulfill their ministry (cf. *Eucharisticum mysterium*, 25), I hereby decree the following in regards to Mass schedules in the Diocese of Camden:

1. A parish may have one Saturday evening Mass.
2. A parish may have two Sunday Masses if there is only one full-time priest assigned to the parish.
3. A parish may have one additional Mass on Sunday per full-time or part-time priest assigned to the parish as long as those Masses have an attendance of at least 60% of the capacity of the church building. A change in the Mass schedule will need to be made when staffing changes at the parish.
4. Parishes that serve the Latino community should incorporate the Mass celebrated in the Spanish language into the parish Mass schedule in accord with the guidelines above.
5. Parishes in the shore region of the diocese will need to plan, on an annual basis, the number of Masses they require and are able to cover. By May 1st of each year, pastors of shore parishes are to file their summer Mass schedule and coverage plan with the Office of the Chancellor.
6. In parishes with only one priest; the parish weekday Mass schedules may reflect the pastor's day off by having no Mass scheduled on that day. In addition, when the pastor is on vacation, the weekday Masses may be suspended. Eucharistic services are NOT TO BE CONDUCTED on these occasions; the faithful are to be provided with nearby parish Mass schedules so that they may participate in Mass.

This decree takes effect on July 1, 2023.

Dear Parishioners of Christ the Good Shepherd Parish,

From time to time, each parish experiences a change in administration. For some parishioners these periods of transition can be difficult, especially when they occur after a period of relative parish stability. However, when these changes take place, they must be marked by the virtue that has since Apostolic times and should be a hallmark of the Christian community: Love.

I say this because there are groups within Christ the Good Shepherd Parish who believe it is acceptable to make scurrilous remarks about the priests and parish staff in written communications which they do not have the courage to sign. The latest of these came from the so-called "Saint Longinus Society of Christ the Good Shepherd Parish." A self-named group that has no proper standing within the parish.

In their document they accuse Father Flores of financial improprieties because they conducted a "forensic audit." The "forensic audit" they undertook was simply to add together the sums reported in the parish bulletin for the weekly collection and compare them to the revenue and expenditure sheet also found in the parish bulletin and dated December 31st. The so-called "Society" found that \$566,359.19 was reported in the parish bulletin while the December 31st report provided by Preziosi Accounting Services totaled \$284,234. The same so-called "Society" then suggested that the difference, \$282,125.19 was missing, inferring that Father Flores had stolen the money. At the end of their letter, the Society raises concern that Father Flores is co-owner of a property at the shore, again alluding that he must be using parish funds to maintain his private home.

The problem is that the report, which is one of four posted each year in the parish bulletin, is a report of the second quarter of the fiscal year (which begins in July) that records figures from July 1st through December 31st and cannot be compared to the annual sum they calculated from the weekly reports. Upon receiving the so-called "Society's" "forensic audit" (which is NO forensic audit), I met with the diocesan finance department to review the financial statements for Christ the Good Shepherd Parish. The facts show that the parish received \$591,932.94 in ordinary income for the year ending December 31, 2022. That amount is higher than the audited figure reported in the parish bulletins.

My office and others that comprise the Chancery of the Diocese of Camden take parishioner concerns very seriously and we answer letters that are typed or handwritten,

received through the postal service, that are signed by the author and provide verifiable contact information. It is impossible to respond to threatening letters from individuals or "societies" who do not have the courage nor Christian charity to stand behind their words and provide proper contact information.

The so-called "Society of Saint Longinus" threatens to take their concerns to court stating that "if [our] requirements [which are really demands which they have no right to make] for an out-of-court settlement are not met, rest assured we will not hesitate to have warrants and subpoenas issued for these individuals and other persons of interest." I would welcome such actions because they would require this group of cowards to disclose their identities.

On behalf of Bishop Sullivan, I express fraternal support for Father Junior Flores and pray that he will continue his ministry of guiding the faithful in Vineland and building up the Parish of the Good Shepherd. On this Sunday when your parish celebrates its feast day, I hope that each of you will pray for your priests and for an increase in vocations to the priesthood in the Diocese of Camden.

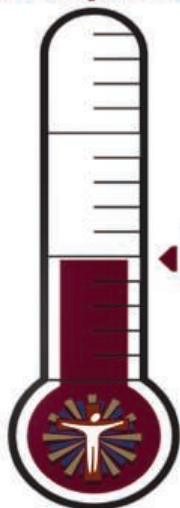

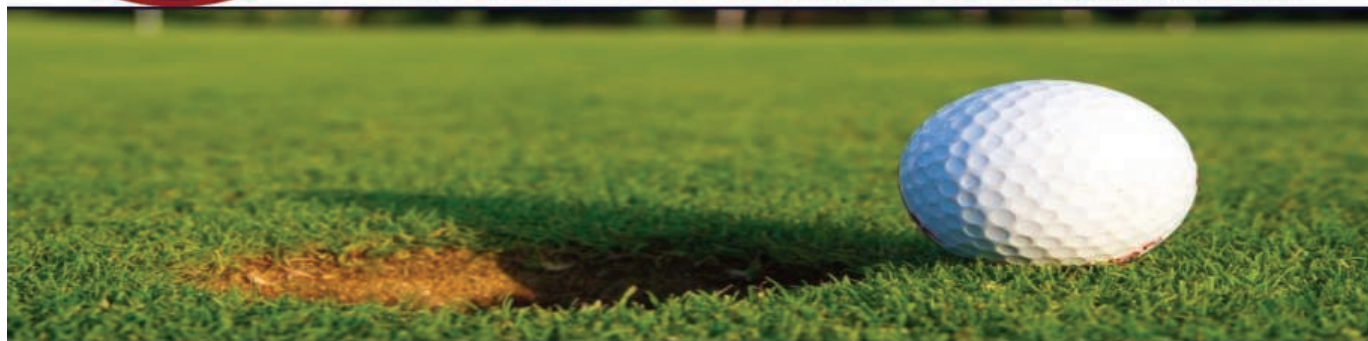
