Readings for Pentecost Sunday

First Reading: Acts 2:1-11

When the time for Pentecost was fulfilled, they were all in one place together. And suddenly there came from the sky a noise like a strong driving wind, and it filled the entire house in which they were. Then there appeared to them tongues as of fire, which parted and came to rest on each one of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in different tongues, as the Spirit enabled them to proclaim.

Now there were devout Jews from every nation under heaven staying in Jerusalem. At this sound, they gathered in a large crowd, but they were confused because each one heard them speaking in his own language. They were astounded, and in amazement they asked, "Are not all these people who are speaking Galileans? Then how does each of us hear them in his native language? We are Parthians, Medes, and Elamites, inhabitants of Mesopotamia, Judea and Cappadocia, Pontus and Asia, Phrygia and Pamphylia, Egypt and the districts of Libya near Cyrene, as well as travelers from Rome, both Jews and converts to Judaism, Cretans and Arabs, yet we hear them speaking in our own tongues of the mighty acts of God."


Profession of Faith:

Administrator's Note

My Dear Friends,

Have we ever felt abandoned by our Lord and Savior? If we are truly honest, we have all come across challenges within our lives that have caused us to doubt, fear, and yes, feel abandoned, not only by Jesus, but maybe by our family and friends. I find it so ironic, that we might question if our Lord abandoned us, and yet, if we recall all His disciples, except one abandoned Him. If our Lord and Savior on the day of His crucifixion cried out to His own Father, "My God, My God, why have you abandoned me?" The feeling of being alone, and abandon is something as Christians we all must face. If Jesus Christ yelled it from the cross, so will we. The question is how we will confront this grief and allow the Glory for God to manifest itself within us.

When we said yes to Jesus, we said yes to the turmoil and chaos that is in the world. It will be up to us to seek out our Lord through all this worldly mess. As we read and hear stories of many Christians, saints, martyrs, and yes, holy men and women who have encountered the "Sounds of Silence" which penetrate our hearts with abandonment, we are reminded of one such saint who battled her darkness. St. Mother Teresa of Calcutta was afflicted with feelings of abandonment by God from the very start of her work among the homeless children and dying persons in Calcutta's slums. According to her personal diaries this experience of abandonment persisted until her death, September of 1997. Her interior struggles were written to her Spiritual Director. In one of the entries St. Mother Teresa wrote, "I am told God lives in me – and yet the reality of darkness and coldness and emptiness is so great that nothing touches my soul." When hearing this quote, I first go numb because I just can't believe that St. Mother Teresa went through something like this, but on the other hand, I can see how the Glory of God worked through someone who felt abandon and touched and help convert so many people in her life.

On this Ascension Sunday, the disciples see Jesus being taken up into heaven. Maybe one of the disciples might think immediately, "now what?" A sense of abandonment might take place among the disciples. They might think, Jesus was with them for such a short time. Jesus spent thirty years preparing for His mission, three years preaching the Good News and three days suffering, dying, and rising from the dead. So, one can see maybe the disciples were a bit confused and might have felt abandoned. But I think there is a moment we all must look at that Jesus is trying to teach His disciples and to teach us. I believe this is a moment of empowerment. Jesus gave us the blueprint and we are called to follow. Those of us who call ourselves His disciples must be empowered to serve everyone. It will be through the power of the Holy Spirit that we will be empowered by the love of God. God's love is empowering, not enslaving us, but making us react to His love for one another.

I recently had this conversation with a Priest friend of mine that I believe is important to say at this time. Many of us in life have gone through so much turmoil, abandonment, personal sin, and just being completely lost. I believe Ascension Sunday teaches us that it's like running a race. It's not how you start, but it's all about how you finish that matters. No matter what we have done in life, we are empowered to become better and servers of God.



**DECREE REGARDING PARISH MASS SCHEDULES
 IN THE DIOCESE OF CAMDEN**

In order to better address the declining number of priests in the presbyterate of the Diocese of Camden, along with the decline in Mass attendance, and having taken counsel with both the Presbyteral Council and the Vicars Forane, in exercising vigilance over the celebration of the sacraments, in accord with canon 392 §2 of the Code of Canon Law, in order that the pastoral effort regarding the celebration of Mass may be more effective for the building up of the ecclesiastical community and so as to not overburden the priests of the diocese, allowing them to more adequately fulfill their ministry (cf. *Eucharisticum mysterium*, 25), I hereby decree the following in regards to Mass schedules in the Diocese of Camden:


1. A parish may have one Saturday evening Mass.
2. A parish may have two Sunday Masses if there is only one full-time priest assigned to the parish.
3. A parish may have one additional Mass on Sunday per full-time or part-time priest assigned to the parish as long as those Masses have an attendance of at least 60% of the capacity of the church building. A change in the Mass schedule will need to be made when staffing changes at the parish.
4. Parishes that serve the Latino community should incorporate the Mass celebrated in the Spanish language into the parish Mass schedule in accord with the guidelines above.
5. Parishes in the shore region of the diocese will need to plan, on an annual basis, the number of Masses they require and are able to cover. By May 1st of each year, pastors of shore parishes are to file their summer Mass schedule and coverage plan with the Office of the Chancellor.
6. In parishes with only one priest; the parish weekday Mass schedules may reflect the pastor's day off by having no Mass scheduled on that day. In addition, when the pastor is on vacation, the weekday Masses may be suspended. Eucharistic services are NOT TO BE CONDUCTED on these occasions; the faithful are to be provided with nearby parish Mass schedules so that they may participate in Mass.

This decree takes effect on July 1, 2023.
