Readings for Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion

Gospel at the Procession: Mt 21:1-11

When Jesus and the disciples drew near Jerusalem and came to Bethphage on the Mount of Olives, Jesus sent two disciples, saying to them, "Go into the village opposite you, and immediately you will find an ass tethered, and a colt with her. Untie them and bring them here to me. And if anyone should say anything to you, reply, 'The master has need of them.' Then he will send them at once." This happened so that what had been spoken through the prophet might be fulfilled: Say to daughter Zion, "Behold, your king comes to you, meek and riding on an ass, and on a colt, the foal of a beast of burden." The disciples went and did as Jesus had ordered them. They brought the ass and the colt and laid their cloaks over them, and he sat upon them. The very large crowd spread their cloaks on the road, while others cut branches from the trees and strewed them on the road. The crowds preceding him and those following kept crying out and saying: "Hosanna to the Son of David; blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord; hosanna in the highest." And when he entered Jerusalem the whole city was shaken and asked, "Who is this?" And the crowds replied, "This is Jesus the prophet, from Nazareth in Galilee."

First Reading: Is 50:4-7

The Lord GOD has given me a well-trained tongue, that I might know how to speak to the weary a word that will rouse them. Morning after morning he opens my ear that I may hear; and I have not rebelled, have not turned back. I gave my back to those who beat me, my cheeks to those who plucked my beard; my face I did not shield from buffets and spitting. The Lord GOD is my help, therefore I am not disgraced; I have set my face like flint, knowing that I shall not be put to shame.

Responsorial Psalm: 22:8-9, 17-18, 19-20, 23-24

Second Reading: Phil 2:6-11

Christ Jesus, though he was in the form of God, did not regard equality with God something to be grasped. Rather, he emptied himself, taking the form of a slave, coming in human likeness; and found human in appearance, he humbled himself, becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross. Because of this, God greatly exalted him and bestowed on him the name which is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bend, of those in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

Gospel: Mt 26:14—27:66


Profession of Faith:

I believe in one, holy, catholic and apostolic Church. I confess one Baptism for the forgiveness of sins and I look forward to the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come. Amen.

Administrator's Note

My Dear Friends,

Do you know the legend of the Cherokee Indian youth's rite of passage?

There is a story of a father who is taking his son to the forest. He will need to blindfold him, and leave alone on a "stump" the entire night. The young boy is required to sit on a "stump" the entire night, and not take off the blindfold, until morning when the sun shines through his blindfold. He will be all by himself, and cannot cry for help to any one. If he survives the night, he is a man. The young boy will not be able to tell of his experiences to any other boy of the tribe. Each boy must come into manhood through their own experiences in the forest.

The young boy is sitting on the stump terrified, and he could hear all kinds of noises around him. These noises were the sounds from wild beasts and maybe some human beings that would hurt him. The wind is blowing hard and it shakes the "stump" the young boy is sitting on. But, the young boy sat stoically, never removing the blindfold, for he knew this would be the only way he could become a man. Finally, after a horrific night the sun appeared and he removed his blindfold. It was then the young boy saw his father sitting on the "stump" next to him. His father stayed at watch the entire night protecting his son from any harm that may have come to him.

This story should remind us that we are never truly alone. Even when we do not know it, our family and yes, our true friends are watching out for us, and sitting on a "stump" beside us. We are reminded that six (6) weeks ago, we entered the desert for a "rite of passage." We entered the desert to deal with the harmful behavior we do to our relationship with Jesus Christ.

Today, just like the young boy, we are invited to sit on a "stump," but to be at watch. To be at that moment and watch the journey of our salvation take place.

We are called to give witness to the journey in which our Lord and Savior is making for our salvation.

We are being challenged. Do we accept this challenge?

There are four words that embody the challenge of a Christian life.

*We find them in the fifth line of The Lord's Prayer (The Our Father): "**Thy will be done.**" These four words present the greatest challenge of Christianity. My best friend and I were having a conversation recently about doing God's Will, and it made me think, during Lent and leading into Holy Week are we doing the Will of the Father. Are our actions as Christians showing the Will of the Father? Are our relationships, family and friends showing the Will of the Father? Let this Holy Week be an invitation and a challenge for our lives in showing the Will of Father.*

May this Holy Week be one of becoming who we are called to be in the "eyes" of our Heavenly Father.

God bless you this Holy Week!




