Readings for Second Sunday of Easter

First Reading: Acts 2:14a, 36-41

Then Peter stood up with the Eleven, raised his voice, and proclaimed: "Let the whole house of Israel know for certain that God has made both Lord and Christ, this Jesus whom you crucified." Now when they heard this, they were cut to the heart, and they asked Peter and the other apostles, "What are we to do, my brothers?" Peter said to them, "Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins; and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. For the promise is made to you and to your children and to all those far off, whomever the Lord our God will call." He testified with many other arguments, and was exhorting them, "Save yourselves from this corrupt generation." Those who accepted his message were baptized, and about three thousand persons were added that day.

Second Reading: 1 Pt 2:20b-25

When he was insulted, he returned no insult; when he suffered, he did not threaten; instead, he handed himself over to the one who judges justly. He himself bore our sins in his body upon the cross, so that, free from sin, we might live for righteousness. By his wounds you have been healed. For you had gone astray like sheep, but you have now returned to the shepherd and guardian of your souls.

Gospel: Jn 10:1-10

Jesus said: "Amen, amen, I say to you, whoever does not enter a sheepfold through the gate but climbs over elsewhere is a thief and a robber. But whoever enters through the gate is the shepherd of the sheep. The gatekeeper opens it for him, and the sheep hear his voice, as the shepherd calls his own sheep by name and leads them out. When he has driven out all his own, he walks ahead of them, and the sheep follow him, because they recognize his voice. But they will not follow a stranger; they will run away from him, because they do not recognize the voice of strangers." Although Jesus used this figure of speech, the Pharisees did not realize what he was trying to tell them.

So Jesus said again, "Amen, amen, I say to you, I am the gate for the sheep. All who came before me are thieves and robbers, but the sheep did not listen to them. I am the gate. Whoever enters through me will be saved, and will come in and go out and find pasture. A thief comes only to steal and slaughter and destroy; I came so that they might have life and have it more abundantly."

For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate, he suffered death and was buried, and rose again on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead and his kingdom will have no end. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son, who with the Father and the Son is adored and glorified, who has spoken through the prophets. I believe in one, holy, catholic and apostolic Church. I confess one Baptism for the forgiveness of sins and I look forward to the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come. Amen.

Administrator's Note

My Dear Friends,

Diana Ross sang a song called "*The theme from Mahogany.*" In the opening line of this song, it asks several questions that I believe we should be asking ourselves.

"Do you know where you're going to?

Do you like the things that life is showing you?

Where are you going to?

Do you know?

Question? *Do we know where we are going to?* We listen to many different voices in this world. Our worldly voices of *addictions*, voices of *attractions*, and voices of *seductions* always try to speak to us and lure us from the voice of our Lord. How well do we recognize the voice of Jesus as the Good Shepherd? The name of our Parish is Christ the Good Shepherd. Our parish name represents who we celebrate today, the Good Shepherd. Have we been an example of discipleship to others in the world that we hear the voice of Jesus Christ in our lives? This is extremely important, since the world does not recognize Him. Do we take the time to listen for His guidance in our life? Do we discern His Word? Or, do we become anxious, impatient, fearful, and doubtful about our lives, that destroys our relationship with Christ and others.

Once again, we encounter the "*fear-factor.*" All those emotions (*doubt, confusion, anxiety, impatient, and fear*), which we have heard and encounter for three weeks now, are front and center to hearing the voice of Jesus Christ. These same emotions and feelings was exactly what the disciples had encounter, since the resurrection of our Lord.

So, what do we do? If we are having problems hearing, don't we believe that discerning the cause is important? If we truly discern the cause, we might find out what we need to change in our lives. We need to have an intimate relationship with our Lord. We want to feel human closeness, but nothings compares to the intimate relationship we have with our Father in Heaven. "*We will discover the truth and the truth will set us free.*" Why can't we have and intimate relationship with our Lord? You see my dear friends, knowing we are personally and intimately loved by Christ, and we are called by name, He invites and encourages us to listen to Him. Do we listen? And if you listen, do you hear? "Hearing" Christ speak to us in this personal and intimate way should motivate us to action. Action to serve others, and being called a disciple. Being intimate with Christ allows us to hear the Good Shepherds voice in all we do in serving Him and His people.

May this Good Shepherd Sunday be one that is intimately expressed gratefully to our Almighty Father in Heaven,



EPISCOPUS CAMDENSIS

DECREE REGARDING PARISH MASS SCHEDULES
IN THE DIOCESE OF CAMDEN


In order to better address the declining number of priests in the presbyterate of the Diocese of Camden, along with the decline in Mass attendance, and having taken counsel with both the Presbyteral Council and the Vicars Forane, in exercising vigilance over the celebration of the sacraments, in accord with canon 392 §2 of the Code of Canon Law, in order that the pastoral effort regarding the celebration of Mass may be more effective for the building up of the ecclesiastical community and so as to not overburden the priests of the diocese, allowing them to more adequately fulfill their ministry (cf. *Eucharisticum mysterium*, 25), I hereby decree the following in regards to Mass schedules in the Diocese of Camden:


1. A parish may have one Saturday evening Mass.
2. A parish may have two Sunday Masses if there is only one full-time priest assigned to the parish.
3. A parish may have one additional Mass on Sunday per full-time or part-time priest assigned to the parish as long as those Masses have an attendance of at least 60% of the capacity of the church building. A change in the Mass schedule will need to be made when staffing changes at the parish.
4. Parishes that serve the Latino community should incorporate the Mass celebrated in the Spanish language into the parish Mass schedule in accord with the guidelines above.
5. Parishes in the shore region of the diocese will need to plan, on an annual basis, the number of Masses they require and are able to cover. By May 1st of each year, pastors of shore parishes are to file their summer Mass schedule and coverage plan with the Office of the Chancellor.
6. In parishes with only one priest; the parish weekday Mass schedules may reflect the pastor's day off by having no Mass scheduled on that day. In addition, when the pastor is on vacation, the weekday Masses may be suspended. Eucharistic services are NOT TO BE CONDUCTED on these occasions; the faithful are to be provided with nearby parish Mass schedules so that they may participate in Mass.


This decree takes effect on July 1, 2023.

Ten Tips for Protecting Children and Offering Outreach to Victims/Survivors

- 1 **Sexual abuse is about the victim.**
Many people are affected by abuse but the individual most impacted is the victim who has suffered a violation of trust that can affect his or her entire life.
- 2 **The residual effects of having been abused can last a lifetime.**
The sense of violation goes deep into a person's psyche and feelings of anger, shame, hurt and betrayal can build long after the abuse has taken place. Those who have been abused can heal, but if often takes time, therapy, and the support of loved ones.
- 3 **No one has the right to have access to children.**
No one, no matter who they are, has an automatic right to be around children or young people who are in the care of the Church without proper screening and without following the rules.
- 4 **Common sense is not all that common.**
Dioceses, schools, parishes, and especially families, must educate themselves and others on how to protect children.
- 5 **Child sexual abuse can be prevented.**
It is critical to build safety barriers around children and young people to keep them from harm—such as protective guardians, codes of conduct, background evaluations, policies and procedures, and safety training programs.
- 6 **Feeling heard leads toward healing.**
Relief from hurt and anger often comes when one feels heard, when one's pain and concerns are taken seriously, and a victim/survivor's suffering, pain, and anger are acknowledged.
- 7 **You cannot always predict who will be an abuser.**
Experience shows that most abuse is committed by someone who has gained the trust of a victim/survivor and his/her family.
- 8 **There are behavioral warning signs of child abusers.**
Some abusers isolate a potential victim by giving him or her undue attention or lavish gifts, others allow young people to participate in activities which their parents or guardians would not approve, such as watching pornography, drinking alcohol, using drugs, and excessive touching, such as wrestling and tickling.
- 9 **People can be taught to identify grooming behavior.**
Grooming behaviors are the actions which abusers take to project the image that they are kind, generous, caring people, while their intent is to lure a minor into an inappropriate relationship. Offenders can be patient and may groom their victim, his or her family, or community for years.
- 10 **Background checks are important.**
Background checks in churches, schools and other organizations keep predators away from children both because they scare off some predators and because they uncover past actions which should ban an adult from working or volunteering with children.




