Readings for the Fourth Sunday of Advent**First Reading:** Is 7:10-14

The LORD spoke to Ahaz, saying: Ask for a sign from the LORD, your God; let it be deep as the netherworld, or high as the sky! But Ahaz answered, "I will not ask! I will not tempt the LORD!" Then Isaiah said: Listen, O house of David! Is it not enough for you to weary people, must you also weary my God? Therefore the Lord himself will give you this sign: the virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall name him Emmanuel.

Paul, a slave of Christ Jesus, called to be an apostle and set apart for the gospel of God, which he promised previously through his prophets in the holy Scriptures, the gospel about his Son, descended from David according to the flesh, but established as Son of God in power according to the Spirit of holiness through resurrection from the dead, Jesus Christ our Lord.

This is how the birth of Jesus Christ came about. When his mother Mary was betrothed to Joseph, but before they lived together, she was found with child through the Holy Spirit. Joseph her husband, since he was a righteous man, yet unwilling to expose her to shame, decided to divorce her quietly. Such was his intention when, behold, the angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream and said, "Joseph, son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary your wife into your home. For it is through the Holy Spirit that this child has been conceived in her. She will bear a son and you are to name him Jesus, because he will save his people from their sins." All this took place to fulfill what the Lord had said through the prophet: Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and they shall name him Emmanuel, which means "God is with us." When Joseph awoke, he did as the angel of the Lord had commanded him and took his wife into his home.


Profession of Faith:

Administrator's Note

My Dear Friends,

Here is a question that I believe we need to ask ourselves. Why is it so important for us to "hear?" In the Gospel today, we "hear" Joseph listening to the angel (Gabriel), as the angel gives instructions to Joseph about Mary in order to protect her. The angel also made a revelation in saying "For it is through the Holy Spirit that this child has been conceived in her. She will bear a son and you are to name him Jesus." The angel revealed the name of the baby to Joseph. Either though it was a dream, Joseph was "hearing" and did everything the angel told him. One can see how grounded Joseph is in his faith. To receive a message in a dream, but respond with faith is nothing more than exceptional. Why is hearing so important? The answer is because our faith is created through hearing. "So faith comes from hearing, and hearing through the word of Christ." (Romans 10:17). Even the Gospel of Luke 4:21 says, while Jesus was in the synagogue teaching, "Today this Scripture has been fulfilled in your hearing." Every Sunday, the Priest prepares a homily and emphasizes the Gospel in a message to transform our lives. We hear scripture coming alive in our hearts. Question? Do we allow scripture to come alive in our hearts? If our hearts are not being changed or transformed from hearing the Word of God, then we need to ask ourselves a few questions. First, how do we make room for God in our lives? Second, how does hearing the Word of God transform our lives? And third, how do we resist talking to God?

On the fourth week of Advent, we light the last purple candle to mark the final week of prayer and penance. The final candle, "Angel's Candle" symbolizes peace. Our Lord is talking to us! Are we hearing Him or are we just listening? Do we want peace in our lives?

For three weeks we have been preparing ourselves for the coming of Jesus. Have we allowed scripture to be fulfilled in our hearing? Usually when we encounter difficulties in hearing the Word of God it's because of one of the following: unbelief, disobedience, trying too hard, distractions, and false expectations. If we are having difficulties let's try and make the final days before the coming of the Lord an opportunity to allow the Word of God to enter our lives and transform us.

Mis queridos amigos,

He aquí una pregunta que creo que debemos hacernos. ¿Por qué es tan importante para nosotros "escuchar"? En el Evangelio de hoy, "escuchamos" a José escuchando al ángel (Gabriel), mientras el ángel le da instrucciones a José acerca de María para protegerla. El ángel también hizo una revelación al decir: "Porque es por medio del Espíritu Santo que este niño ha sido concebido en ella. Ella dará a luz un hijo y le pondrás por nombre Jesús". El ángel reveló el nombre del bebé a José. Aunque era un sueño, José estaba "oyendo" e hizo todo lo que el ángel le dijo. Uno puede ver cómo José cimentó su fe. Recibir un mensaje en sueño, pero responder con fe no es más que excepcional. ¿Por qué es tan importante escuchar? La respuesta es porque nuestra fe se crea a través del oír. "Así que la fe es por el oír, y el oír por la palabra de Cristo." (Romanos 10:17). Incluso el Evangelio de Lucas 4:21 dice, mientras Jesús estaba en la sinagoga enseñando: "Hoy se ha cumplido esta Escritura delante de vosotros". Cada domingo, el Sacerdote prepara una homilía y enfatiza el Evangelio en un mensaje para transformar nuestras vidas. Oímos que las Escrituras cobran vida en nuestros corazones. ¿Pregunta? ¿Permitimos que las Escrituras cobren vida en nuestros corazones? Si nuestros corazones no están siendo cambiados o transformados al escuchar la Palabra de Dios, entonces debemos hacernos algunas preguntas. Primero, ¿cómo hacemos lugar para Dios en nuestra vida? Segundo, ¿cómo transforma nuestra vida escuchar la Palabra de Dios? Y tercero, ¿cómo me resisto a hablar con Dios?

En la cuarta semana de Adviento, encendemos la última vela morada para marcar la última semana de oración y penitencia. La vela final, "Vela del Ángel" simboliza la paz. ¡Nuestro Señor nos está hablando! ¿Lo estamos escuchando o solo estamos escuchando? ¿Queremos paz en nuestras vidas?

Durante tres semanas nos hemos estado preparando para la venida de Jesús. ¿Hemos permitido que las escrituras se cumplan en nuestra audiencia? Por lo general, cuando encontramos dificultades para escuchar la Palabra de Dios, se debe a uno de los siguientes: incredulidad, desobediencia, esforzarse demasiado, distracciones y falsas expectativas. Si tenemos dificultades, tratemos de hacer de los últimos días antes de la venida del Señor una oportunidad para permitir que la Palabra de Dios entre en nuestras vidas y nos transforme.
