## Readings for the Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time

### **First Reading: Lv 19:1-2, 17-18**

The LORD said to Moses, "Speak to the whole Israelite community and tell them: Be holy, for I, the LORD, your God, am holy. "You shall not bear hatred for your brother or sister in your heart. Though you may have to reprove your fellow citizen, do not incur sin because of him. Take no revenge and cherish no grudge against any of your people. You shall love your neighbor as yourself. I am the LORD."

If any one among you considers himself wise in this age, let him become a fool, so as to become wise. For the wisdom of this world is foolishness in the eyes of God, for it is written: God catches the wise in their own ruses, and again: The Lord knows the thoughts of the wise, that they are vain. So let no one boast about human beings, for everything belongs to you, Paul or Apollos or Cephas, or the world or life or death, or the present or the future: all belong to you, and you to Christ, and Christ to God.

**Gospel: Mt 5:38-48**

Jesus said to his disciples: "You have heard that it was said, An eye for an eye and a tooth for a tooth. But I say to you, offer no resistance to one who is evil. When someone strikes you on your right cheek, turn the other one as well. If anyone wants to go to law with you over your tunic, hand over your cloak as well. Should anyone press you into service for one mile, go for two miles. Give to the one who asks of you, and do not turn your back on one who wants to borrow.

"You have heard that it was said, You shall love your neighbor and hate your enemy. But I say to you, love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you, that you may be children of your heavenly Father, for he makes his sun rise on the bad and the good, and causes rain to fall on the just and the unjust. For if you love those who love you, what recompense will you have? Do not the tax collectors do the same? And if you greet your brothers only, what is unusual about that? Do not the pagans do the same? So be perfect, just as your heavenly Father is perfect."

He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead and his kingdom will have no end. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son, who with the Father and the Son is adored and glorified, who has spoken through the prophets. I believe in one, holy, catholic and apostolic Church. I confess one Baptism for the forgiveness of sins and I look forward to the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come. Amen.

### Administrator's Note

My Dear Friends,

I remember singing this song when I was young, *"It's a beautiful day in this neighborhood, A beautiful day for a neighbor. Would you be mine? Could you be mine? It's a neighborly day in this beauty wood, A neighborly day for a beauty, would you be mine? Could you be mine? I have always wanted to have a neighbor just like you, I've always wanted to live in a neighborhood with you. So, let's make the most of this beautiful day, since we're together we might as well say, would you be mine? Could you be mine? Won't you be my neighbor? Won't you please, Won't you please? Please won't you be my neighbor?"*

I grew up thinking the song was somewhat "corny," but through maturity and understanding, I have come to realize the underlying foundation these words bring to today's Gospel. The most important question, how are we following the Lord's commandments *"To Love the Lord your God and to Love thy neighbor?"* How are we loving our neighbor? One of the Christian core values is to love our neighbor. How are we dealing with that? If many of us are honest, we have some work to do. If this was being accomplished, we would be living in peace. Peace in the world. Peace in the United States. Peace in our communities, and yes, peace within our own Church. It's truly sad to say and to witness that public kindness and compassion are extremely scarce, but this does not have to be. We can begin to change. We can begin to be kind, instead of hateful. We can begin to show compassion and forgiveness. However, because of hurt, pain, and our sinfulness, which breaks our relationship with God, we have the tendency for idol gossip, which destroys someone's reputation, and demonstrates lack of Christian charity and respect towards one another. When we behave like this it destroys the core value of loving your neighbor. In last week's gospel we heard and were challenged by our Lord, *"Therefore, if you bring your gift to the altar, and there recall that your brother has anything against you, leave your gift there at the altar, go first and be reconciled with your brother, and then come and offer your gift."* (Mt 5:17-37)

We need to begin to learn how to reconcile. Reconcile with one another. We as Christian, need to be people of prayer asking the Lord to be better. We need to ask for forgiveness, so we can forgive others. I have learned something so important in my life about being a neighbor to others and that is true forgiveness. You see, when we begin to show true forgiveness, we show compassion, understanding, and mercy, and I know that is what our Lord shows us.

In my homily last week, I said, *"Actions prove who you are, and words prove who you want to be."* Question? Are our actions showing who we are as Christians? My mother always preached to me "you treat people the way you want to be treated and you will never go wrong."

Question? How are we behaving to our neighbor? Are we loving our neighbor, or do we have work to do?

Queridos amigos,

Recuerdo que cantaba esta canción cuando era joven, *"Es un hermoso día en este vecindario, Un hermoso día para un vecino. ¿Podrías ser mío? ¿Podrías ser mía? Es un día de vecindad en este hermoso bosque, Un día de vecindad para una belleza, ¿Podrías ser mía? ¿Podrías ser mía? Siempre he querido tener un vecino como tú, siempre he querido vivir en un vecindario contigo. Así que, aprovechemos este hermoso día, ya que estamos juntos podríamos decir, ¿serías mía? ¿Podrías ser mía? ¿Quieres ser mi vecino? ¿No quieres por favor? ¿No quieres por favor? Por favor, ¿no serás mi vecino?"*

Crecí pensando que la canción era algo "curioso", pero a través de la madurez y la comprensión, he llegado a darme cuenta del fundamento subyacente que estas palabras aportan al Evangelio de hoy. La pregunta más importante, ¿cómo estamos siguiendo los mandamientos del Señor *"Amar al Señor tu Dios y Amar a tu prójimo"*? ¿Cómo estamos amando a nuestro prójimo? Uno de los valores fundamentales del cristianismo es amar al prójimo. ¿Cómo lo estamos cumpliendo? Si muchos de nosotros somos honestos, tenemos trabajo que hacer. Si esto se estuviera cumpliendo, viviríamos en paz. Paz en el mundo. Paz en los Estados Unidos. Paz en nuestras comunidades, y sí, paz dentro de nuestra propia Iglesia. Es verdaderamente triste decir y presenciar que la bondad y la compasión públicas son extremadamente escasas, pero esto no tiene por qué ser así. Podemos empezar a cambiar. Podemos empezar a ser amables, en lugar de odiosos. Podemos empezar a mostrar compasión y perdón. Sin embargo, debido a la herida, al dolor y a nuestra pecaminosidad, que rompe nuestra relación con Dios, tenemos la tendencia a los chismes ídolos, que destruyen la reputación de alguien, y demuestran falta de caridad cristiana y de respeto hacia los demás. Cuando nos comportamos así, destruimos el valor fundamental de amar al prójimo. En el evangelio de la semana pasada escuchamos y fuimos retados por nuestro Señor: *"Por lo tanto, si traes tu ofrenda al altar, y allí te acuerdas de que tu hermano tiene algo contra ti, deja allí tu ofrenda en el altar, vete primero a reconciliarte con tu hermano, y entonces ven y ofrece tu ofrenda."* (Mt 5, 17-37)

Tenemos que empezar a aprender a reconciliarnos. Reconciliarnos los unos con los otros. Nosotros, como cristianos, necesitamos ser personas de oración pidiendo al Señor ser mejores. Necesitamos pedir perdón, para poder perdonar a los demás. He aprendido algo muy importante en mi vida acerca de ser un prójimo para los demás y es el verdadero perdón. Cuando empezamos a mostrar verdadero perdón, mostramos compasión, comprensión y misericordia, y sé que eso es lo que nuestro Señor nos muestra.

En mi homilía de la semana pasada, dije: *"Las acciones demuestran quién eres, y las palabras demuestran quién quieres ser"*. ¿Preguntas? ¿Muestran nuestras acciones lo que somos como cristianos? Mi madre siempre me predicaba "trata a la gente como quieres que te traten y nunca te equivocarás".

¿Pregunta? ¿Cómo nos comportamos con nuestro prójimo? ¿Estamos amando a nuestro prójimo, o tenemos trabajo que hacer?


