## Readings for the First Sunday of Lent

### **First Reading: Gn 2:7-9; 3:1-7**

The LORD God formed man out of the clay of the ground and blew into his nostrils the breath of life, and so man became a living being. Then the LORD God planted a garden in Eden, in the east, and placed there the man whom he had formed. Out of the ground the LORD God made various trees grow that were delightful to look at and good for food, with the tree of life in the middle of the garden and the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. Now the serpent was the most cunning of all the animals that the LORD God had made. The serpent asked the woman, "Did God really tell you not to eat from any of the trees in the garden?" The woman answered the serpent: "We may eat of the fruit of the trees in the garden; it is only about the fruit of the tree in the middle of the garden that God said, 'You shall not eat it or even touch it, lest you die.'" But the serpent said to the woman: "You certainly will not die! No, God knows well that the moment you eat of it your eyes will be opened and you will be like gods who know what is good and what is evil." The woman saw that the tree was good for food, pleasing to the eyes, and desirable for gaining wisdom. So she took some of its fruit and ate it; and she also gave some to her husband, who was with her, and he ate it. Then the eyes of both of them were opened, and they realized that they were naked; so they sewed fig leaves together and made loincloths for themselves.

### **Second Reading: Rom 5:12-19**

Brothers and sisters: Through one man sin entered the world, and through sin, death, and thus death came to all men, inasmuch as all sinned for up to the time of the law, sin was in the world, though sin is not accounted when there is no law. But death reigned from Adam to Moses, even over those who did not sin after the pattern of the trespass of Adam, who is the type of the one who was to come. But the gift is not like the transgression. For if by the transgression of the one, the many died, how much more did the grace of God and the gracious gift of the one man Jesus Christ overflow for the many. And the gift is not like the result of the one who sinned. For after one sin there was the judgment that brought condemnation; but the gift, after many transgressions, brought acquittal. For if, by the transgression of the one, death came to reign through that one, how much more will those who receive the abundance of grace and of the gift of justification come to reign in life through the one Jesus Christ. In conclusion, just as through one transgression condemnation came upon all, so, through one righteous act, acquittal and life came to all. For just as through the disobedience of the one man the many were made sinners, so, through the obedience of the one, the many will be made righteous.

### **Verse Before the Gospel: Mt 4:4**

One does not live on bread alone, but on every word that comes forth from the mouth of God.

**Gospel: Mt 4:1-11**

At that time Jesus was led by the Spirit into the desert to be tempted by the devil. He fasted for forty days and forty nights, and afterwards he was hungry. The tempter approached and said to him, "If you are the Son of God, command that these stones become loaves of bread." He said in reply, "It is written: One does not live on bread alone, but on every word that comes forth from the mouth of God." Then the devil took him to the holy city, and made him stand on the parapet of the temple, and said to him, "If you are the Son of God, throw yourself down. For it is written: He will command his angels concerning you and with their hands they will support you, lest you dash your foot against a stone." Jesus answered him, "Again it is written, You shall not put the Lord, your God, to the test." Then the devil took him up to a very high mountain, and showed him all the kingdoms of the world in their magnificence, and he said to him, "All these I shall give to you, if you will prostrate yourself and worship me." At this, Jesus said to him, "Get away, Satan! It is written: The Lord, your God, shall you worship and him alone shall you serve." Then the devil left him and, behold, angels came and ministered to him.

**Profession of Faith:**

I believe in one God, the Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible. I believe in one Lord Jesus Christ, the Only Begotten Son of God, born of the Father before all ages. God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, consubstantial with the Father; through him all things were made. For us men and for our salvation he came down from heaven,

**and by the Holy Spirit was incarnate of the Virgin Mary, and became man.**

For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate, he suffered death and was buried, and rose again on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead and his kingdom will have no end. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son, who with the Father and the Son is adored and glorified, who has spoken through the prophets. I believe in one, holy, catholic and apostolic Church. I confess one Baptism for the forgiveness of sins and I look forward to the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come. Amen.

### Administrator's Note

My Dear Friends,

The word “encounter” has both a positive and negative meaning for many of us. It’s safe to say, if we are honest, many of us do not like confrontations, but to look at our lives, we must encounter the very things that takes us from our relationship with Lord. The definition of encounter is an *“unexpectedly experience or be faced with something difficult or hostile.”*

Question: During lent, are we ready for an encounter? In today’s Gospel we hear *“At that time Jesus was led by the Spirit into the desert to be tempted by the devil. He fasted for forty days and forty nights, and afterwards he was hungry.”* Jesus was led to the desert to have an encounter with Satan. Satan encountered Jesus in three ways. First, Satan attempted to get Jesus to put His own needs and potential concerns above the will of His Father. Second, Satan wanted Jesus to act independently of His Father. Third, Satan wanted Jesus to sacrifice His secure future for the present. Jesus demonstrated to us that He met Satan’s challenge by trusting in His Father. For us our challenge comes to us this lent by encountering the very things that separate us from our Lord. Are we ready for this encounter? Are we ready for this challenge? It’s important to realize whether we choose to encounter Satan in the desert this lent, we must be ready to look at the very things that separates us from the love of God. Satan will powerfully lure us into traps that separates us from our Lord. These traps range from our thoughts in which we keep secretly in our minds to our very actions and feelings that penetrate so deep in our hearts. These actions make us say and do many thing that are destructive to our relationship with our Lord and others.

It’s important to remember that before the moment in which Jesus was led to the desert by the Spirit, He was baptized. Our Lord was ready to embark on His journey and begin His public ministry. We must remember, we are baptized children of our Lord, who are called into service of *“Loving the Lord our God and Loving our neighbor.”* This comes from bettering ourselves as people who proclaim His name. We must be strong and confront our sinfulness and turn to the Lord and follow Him. Satan will not be cavalier on his approach in wanting to destroy our relationship with our Lord. Satan will be relentless. We must be ready to accept this challenge, so we can be the best version of ourselves. **This is what it means if we accept the encounter and enter the desert.** It’s always important to know if we stumble our Lord shows us mercy. We must learn to be patient with ourselves and rise again and continue this spiritual warfare with the devil. The devil is tricky, and he will do his best to lure and entice us with worldly and material desires have removed our eyes from our Lord. We must remember that it’s with the Lord’s grace, we can overcome any obstacles.

I leave you with my final thoughts:

*Sometimes it takes certain things falling apart for better things to fall into place. Sometimes it takes losing what we are settling for to remind us of what we truly deserve.*

*Sometimes it takes the most uncomfortable path to lead our life to the most beautiful place.*

*I know it’s hard. It’s very hard.*

*But will never see the purpose of the STORM in our life, until you see the growth that it produces.*

Again, are we ready to enter the desert for this encounter? We will see our storms, but if we keep our eyes on God, our Lord has shown us He is merciful and we can overcome the lures of the devil. Are we ready for this challenge?




