When eight days were completed for his circumcision, he was named Jesus, the name given him by the angel before he was conceived in the womb.

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son, who with the Father and the Son is adored and glorified, who has spoken through the prophets. I believe in one, holy, catholic and apostolic Church. I confess one Baptism for the forgiveness of sins and I look forward to the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come. Amen.






Epiphany Home Blessing



At one time or another, many have seen the chalk markings on the inside or outside lintel of a door. What does this mean? On the Feast of the Epiphany, we celebrate the Magi visiting the infant Jesus to honor Him as the come Messiah. The tradition has been for families to gather with the parish priest who blesses the entrance door for Jesus to be a daily guest in the home. The markings are made with blessed chalk representing the new year and the first initials of the Magi 20+C+M+B+23, along with the family reciting prayers with the priest. The rooms of the home are also blessed with holy water.

Father Infanti will offer this blessing for the homes of any parishioners who would like to have the Epiphany Home Blessing. The markings are traditionally done with blessed chalk on the lintel OR by placing a printed marker instead. If you would like your home blessed, please call the office (856) 691-9077 and a time for the blessing can be scheduled on a Monday, Wednesday or Saturday January through February.

Ten January Activities for Catholic Families

5. Do an Epiphany Home Blessings by writing 20+C+B+M+18 above your front door in chalk (using the current year). 6. Go star gazing to celebrate Epiphany. Have the children to find the brightest stars in the sky. Discuss how the wise men might have felt while they were traveling to meet the new King, Jesus.

8. To celebrate the Baptism of Our Lord (Sunday after Epiphany), share pictures and keepsakes of your children's baptisms with them. Tell them about the events and emotions of that day.

10. Try to learn to juggle like Saint John Bosco (January 31st) did to entertain people.


