**Readings for the Third Sunday in Ordinary Time****First Reading:** Is 8:23—9:3

First the Lord degraded the land of Zebulun and the land of Naphtali; but in the end he has glorified the seaward road, the land west of the Jordan, the District of the Gentiles. Anguish has taken wing, dispelled is darkness: for there is no gloom where but now there was distress. The people who walked in darkness have seen a great light; upon those who dwelt in the land of gloom a light has shone. You have brought them abundant joy and great rejoicing, as they rejoice before you as at the harvest, as people make merry when dividing spoils. For the yoke that burdened them, the pole on their shoulder, and the rod of their taskmaster you have smashed, as on the day of Midian.

I urge you, brothers and sisters, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that all of you agree in what you say, and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be united in the same mind and in the same purpose. For it has been reported to me about you, my brothers and sisters, by Chloe's people, that there are rivalries among you. I mean that each of you is saying, "I belong to Paul," or "I belong to Apollos," or "I belong to Cephas," or "I belong to Christ." Is Christ divided? Was Paul crucified for you? Or were you baptized in the name of Paul? For Christ did not send me to baptize but to preach the gospel, and not with the wisdom of human eloquence, so that the cross of Christ might not be emptied of its meaning.

**Gospel:** Mt 4:12-23 or 4:12-17

When Jesus heard that John had been arrested, he withdrew to Galilee. He left Nazareth and went to live in Capernaum by the sea, in the region of Zebulun and Naphtali, that what had been said through Isaiah the prophet might be fulfilled: Land of Zebulun and land of Naphtali, the way to the sea, beyond the Jordan, Galilee of the Gentiles, the people who sit in darkness have seen a great light, on those dwelling in a land overshadowed by death light has arisen. From that time on, Jesus began to preach and say, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand."

As he was walking by the Sea of Galilee, he saw two brothers, Simon who is called Peter, and his brother Andrew, casting a net into the sea; they were fishermen. He said to them, "Come after me, and I will make you fishers of men. At once they left their nets and followed him. He walked along from there and saw two other brothers, James, the son of Zebedee, and his brother John. They were in a boat, with their father Zebedee, mending their nets. He called them, and immediately they left their boat and their father and followed him. He went around all of Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, proclaiming the gospel of the kingdom, and curing every disease and illness among the people.

For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate, he suffered death and was buried, and rose again on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead and his kingdom will have no end. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son, who with the Father and the Son is adored and glorified, who has spoken through the prophets. I believe in one, holy, catholic and apostolic Church. I confess one Baptism for the forgiveness of sins and I look forward to the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come. Amen.

## Administrator's Note

My Dear Friends,

In my homily last week, I gave two reasons why God wants us to be committed to Him. One, God wants us to be committed to Him, so the world may know He is important. Second, God wants us to be committed to Him, so He can strengthen us to become what He created us to be. I further went on to say that it's our commitment that gives witness and shows everyone in the world how important God is in our lives.

Now, in today's Gospel reading we hear how Jesus begins the search for His disciples. For Peter and Andrew, Jesus said to them, "Come after me." For James and John, the Gospel of Matthew said, "**He called them.**" Wow! Can you imagine that encounter? The Lord's presence must have been unbelievable and so powerful. His calling must have shaken the inner most being of Peter, Andrew, James, and John that they ended up leaving everything in their lives to follow Jesus.

As you are aware, the call to discipleship takes commitment. Our disciples demonstrated to us what we must do follow Christ. What does this mean for us? Well, like the disciples, we who have made the decision to commit to our Lord and to do His Will, must ask ourselves one huge question.

How do I understand the will of God in my life?

If we call ourselves disciples, we should be asking this question, so we can further follow Him and do His will.

One avenue that has helped me in my journey has been changing the way I think about things. I would like to share with you one of my favorite passages from the Letter of St. Paul to the Romans. Romans 12:2, "**Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good acceptable and perfect.**"

Paul told the believers in Rome not to conform to the standard of the world around them. Instead, he told them to transform their minds – to change from one way of thinking to another. The passage above my friends from St. Paul illustrates to us how we must change the way we think, so we can commit and find that call to discipleship and enter into a relationship with God.

I leave you with one last question. Our Lord wants a relationship with us. It is why, He tells us in Gospel today to "*Come after me.*"

Question? What is it in our lives that keeps us from the true call of discipleship?

En mi homilía de la semana pasada, di dos razones por las que Dios quiere que nos comprometamos con Él. En primer lugar, Dios quiere que nos comprometamos con Él, para que el mundo sepa que Él es importante. En segundo lugar, Dios quiere que nos comprometamos con Él, para que pueda fortalecernos y convertirnos en aquello para lo que nos creó. Y continué diciendo que es nuestro compromiso el que da testimonio y muestra a todo el mundo lo importante que es Dios en nuestras vidas.

Ahora, en la lectura del Evangelio de hoy escuchamos cómo Jesús comienza la búsqueda de sus discípulos. A Pedro y Andrés, Jesús les dice: "**Venid en pos de mí**". Para Santiago y Juan, el Evangelio de Mateo dice: "Los llamó". ¡Vaya! ¿Te imaginas ese encuentro? La presencia del Señor debió de ser increíble y tan poderosa. Su llamada debió sacudir el ser más íntimo de Pedro, Andrés, Santiago y Juan que acabaron dejándolo todo en sus vidas para seguir a Jesús.

Como ustedes saben, la llamada al discipulado requiere compromiso. Nuestros discípulos nos demostraron lo que debemos hacer para seguir a Cristo. ¿Qué significa esto para nosotros? Bueno, como los discípulos, nosotros que hemos tomado la decisión de comprometernos con nuestro Señor y hacer Su Voluntad, debemos hacernos una gran pregunta. ¿Cómo entiendo la voluntad de Dios en mi vida?

Si nos llamamos discípulos, deberíamos hacernos esta pregunta, para poder seguirle más y hacer Su voluntad.

Una vía que me ha ayudado en mi camino ha sido cambiar la forma en que pienso sobre las cosas. Me gustaría compartir con ustedes uno de mis pasajes favoritos de la Carta de San Pablo a los Romanos. Romanos 12:2, "**No os conforméis a este mundo, sino transformaos por medio de la renovación de vuestra mente, para que mediante la prueba podáis discernir cuál es la voluntad de Dios, lo bueno, lo aceptable y lo perfecto.**"

Pablo les dijo a los creyentes de Roma que no se conformaran a las normas del mundo que los rodeaba. Por el contrario, les dijo que transformaran sus mentes - que cambiaran de una forma de pensar a otra. El pasaje anterior de San Pablo, amigos míos, nos ilustra cómo debemos cambiar nuestra forma de pensar, para poder comprometernos y encontrar esa llamada al discipulado y entrar en una relación con Dios.

Les dejo con una última pregunta. Nuestro Señor quiere una relación con nosotros. Por eso, nos dice en el Evangelio de hoy: "*Venid en pos de mí*".

¿Pregunta? ¿Qué hay en nuestras vidas que nos aleja de la verdadera llamada del discipulado?

At one time or another, many have seen the chalk markings on the inside or outside lintel of a door. What does this mean? On the Feast of the Epiphany, we celebrate the Magi visiting the infant Jesus to honor Him as the come Messiah. The tradition has been for families to gather with the parish priest who blesses the entrance door for Jesus to be a daily guest in the home. The markings are made with blessed chalk representing the new year and the first initials of the Magi 20+C+M+B+23, along with the family reciting prayers with the priest. The rooms of the home are also blessed with holy water.

Father Infanti will offer this blessing for the homes of any parishioners who would like to have the Epiphany Home Blessing. The markings are traditionally done with blessed chalk on the lintel OR by placing a printed marker instead. ## IMPORTANT INFORMATION PLEASE READ

Due to parishioners at Christ the Good Shepherd Parish, we have been outsourcing our bulk mailing for many years. Monthly collection envelopes and holiday envelopes are two of the services provided. As with most bulk mailing companies, envelope information must be submitted two months prior to the new mailing company. Unbeknownst to us, the company we were using closed their mailing department and has given our account to a new mailing company. Since this change, we have experienced issues and delays with our bulk mailings and parishioner collection envelopes. We have been diligently working with our contact at the new mailing company to correct this issue, with poor results.

In the new year, Christ the Good Shepherd Parish will be looking for a new company for bulk mailings and collection envelopes. We apologize for any inconvenience this may have caused. Until this is resolved, please use regular envelopes writing your name and envelope number, if you have it, so you can still get credit for your tithes.



The Knights of Columbus Aranjo Chapter is partnering with Cape May County New Jersey Right to Life to sponsor a bus trip to the 2023 March for Life in Washington, DC. The bus is a first-class touring coach with on-board restroom and will make very brief stops along the way for meals and bathroom breaks; there is no cost to passengers for the bus transportation, but riders are responsible for their own meals/refreshments and we ask at least \$5.00 each toward a tip for the driver.

The March for Life is an inspiring, peaceful, vibrant, and joy-filled rally of women, men, young people, and children from all across the country. Every year, tens of thousands of pro-lifers converge on the National Mall and march on Capitol Hill on the anniversary of the Supreme Court's 1973 Roe v. Wade ruling which legalized abortion in all 50 states. It's the largest annual human rights demonstration in the world. But this is not simply a protest: TOGETHER, WE GATHER TO CELEBRATE LIFE. We celebrate each and every life, from the moment of conception. We envision a world where every life is celebrated, valued, and protected.

Even with the wonderful blessing of Roe v. Wade being overturned, which allows more freedom at the state level to enact pro-life laws, the necessary work to build a culture of life in the United States of America is not finished. Rather, it is focused differently. Sadly, the number of abortions annually is still well over 900,000 each year, and that number is expected to decrease only by roughly 200,000 in a post-Roe America. Many national legislative battles loom, including even keeping longstanding Hyde protections, which limit government funding for abortion on annual appropriation bills. The Hyde Amendment has saved over 2 million lives and is arguably the most impactful pro-life policy in our nation's history, but now cannot be taken for granted. Last, our most important work is changing hearts and minds. The goal of the national March for Life is to not only change laws at the state and federal level, but to change the culture to ultimately make abortion unthinkable.

This year's theme is *Next Steps: Marching in a Post-Roe America*

The Pre-March Rally features a live concert and inspiring speeches from pro-life leaders, sharing how to stay involved in the pro-life movement all year long. The March for Life will begin immediately following the Rally starting between 12th and 14th Streets, marching peacefully up Constitution Avenue to the steps of the US Capitol Building; more information can be found at: [www.MarchForLife.org](http://www.MarchForLife.org)




