Readings for The Ascension of the Lord Ascension

First Reading: Acts 1:1-11

In the first book, Theophilus, I dealt with all that Jesus did and taught until the day he was taken up, after giving instructions through the Holy Spirit to the apostles whom he had chosen. He presented himself alive to them by many proofs after he had suffered, appearing to them during forty days and speaking about the kingdom of God. While meeting with the them, he enjoined them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for “the promise of the Father about which you have heard me speak; for John baptized with water, but in a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit.” When they had gathered together they asked him, “Lord, are you at this time going to restore the kingdom to Israel?” He answered them, “It is not for you to know the times or seasons that the Father has established by his own authority. But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, throughout Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.” When he had said this, as they were looking on, he was lifted up, and a cloud took him from their sight. While they were looking intently at the sky as he was going, suddenly two men dressed in white garments stood beside them. They said, “Men of Galilee, why are you standing there looking at the sky? This Jesus who has been taken up from you into heaven will return in the same way as you have seen him going into heaven.”

Brothers and sisters: May the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, give you a Spirit of wisdom and revelation resulting in knowledge of him. May the eyes of your hearts be enlightened, that you may know what is the hope that belongs to his call, what are the riches of glory in his inheritance among the holy ones, and what is the surpassing greatness of his power for us who believe, in accord with the exercise of his great might, which he worked in Christ, raising him from the dead and seating him at his right hand in the heavens, far above every principality, authority, power, and dominion, and every name that is named not only in this age but also in the one to come. And he put all things beneath his feet and gave him as head over all things to the church, which is his body, the fullness of the one who fills all things in every way.

Gospel: Mt 28:16-20

The eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain to which Jesus had ordered them. When they saw him, they worshiped, but they doubted. Then Jesus approached and said to them, “All power in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age.”

Profession of Faith:

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son, who with the Father and the Son is adored and glorified, who has spoken through the prophets. I believe in one, holy, catholic and apostolic Church. I confess one Baptism for the forgiveness of sins and I look forward to the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come. Amen.

Administrator's Note

My Dear Friends,

We hear in the Gospel today, on this Ascension Sunday, "When they saw him, they worshiped, but they doubted."

*All too often, my dear friends, we have false images of what it is to be a perfect Christian, or may I say a perfect Catholic. For us in the Catholic Church, we often think the ideal Catholic must be a Saint that never struggles in their faith and/or never doubts. We have this conception in our mind that all Catholics must always speak in a gentle voice, never swear, and have faith that is never changing or frustrating. Well, if I must say, we need to leave the **"yellow brick road mentality."** All Catholics, all Christians, all peoples, come up short and fail, bottom-line. We are all sinners, and we must realize this about ourselves. It's safe to say, no one walks on water, and on this Ascension Sunday, it's extremely important for us to hear the words of Jesus to His disciples, ... **"Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you..."***

The disciples worshiped, but they doubted. Question? What does that say about us today. If the disciples struggled, we would also struggle. Time and time again, we hear in the Gospels and the letters from Peter to Paul, how the disciples, struggled with their faith and with their obedience to Jesus. My dear friends, it's important to recognize that when we doubt, it takes root in our minds, and then, the doubt creeps into our life, and we approach our lives in one of two ways: We bury our doubt and never deal with it, we just never bring it to the Lord, and 2) when we doubt we start believing that we are not worthy to be saved and to be apart of the Kingdom.

In the Gospel today, right after we are told that the disciples doubted, it says that Jesus came and approached them. Jesus did not distance Himself because they doubted, but immediately steps in to commission His disciples. I am positive there is more to the story regarding the disciples and doubting, but we have heard for several weeks after the crucifixion of our Lord how the disciples were scared, anxious, fearful, and doubted. Jesus in the Gospel today says something that we must remember, and we must make sense of it. Jesus makes a declaration to us. He says, "All power on heaven and earth has been given to me." Jesus is basically saying, "I am bigger than your doubt!" When doubt creeps into our faith, we do not need to pretend that it does not exist or that because of it, God is not still calling us. The disciples stood before our Lord, and they doubted. God's reply was to draw closer to the disciples and to declare His power and authority to them. In our moments of doubt, we need to understand that the Lord desires to do the same in our lives. Far from being bushed away, Jesus wants to come closer. When we feel like the work of the Kingdom, or the teaching of the Church is more than we can handle, we need to remember that God is bigger than the anxiety or fear we may feel. So, go, and baptize and make disciples, in the Name of the Father and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

May this Ascension Sunday be one of NO doubt,

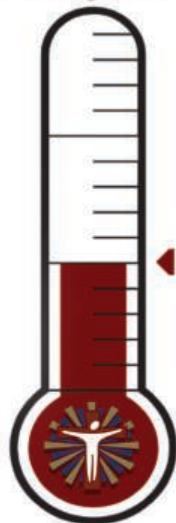

DECREE REGARDING PARISH MASS SCHEDULES
IN THE DIOCESE OF CAMDEN

In order to better address the declining number of priests in the presbyterate of the Diocese of Camden, along with the decline in Mass attendance, and having taken counsel with both the Presbyteral Council and the Vicars Forane, in exercising vigilance over the celebration of the sacraments, in accord with canon 392 §2 of the Code of Canon Law, in order that the pastoral effort regarding the celebration of Mass may be more effective for the building up of the ecclesiastical community and so as to not overburden the priests of the diocese, allowing them to more adequately fulfill their ministry (cf. *Eucharisticum mysterium*, 25), I hereby decree the following in regards to Mass schedules in the Diocese of Camden:

1. A parish may have one Saturday evening Mass.
2. A parish may have two Sunday Masses if there is only one full-time priest assigned to the parish.
3. A parish may have one additional Mass on Sunday per full-time or part-time priest assigned to the parish as long as those Masses have an attendance of at least 60% of the capacity of the church building. A change in the Mass schedule will need to be made when staffing changes at the parish.
4. Parishes that serve the Latino community should incorporate the Mass celebrated in the Spanish language into the parish Mass schedule in accord with the guidelines above.
5. Parishes in the shore region of the diocese will need to plan, on an annual basis, the number of Masses they require and are able to cover. By May 1st of each year, pastors of shore parishes are to file their summer Mass schedule and coverage plan with the Office of the Chancellor.
6. In parishes with only one priest; the parish weekday Mass schedules may reflect the pastor's day off by having no Mass scheduled on that day. In addition, when the pastor is on vacation, the weekday Masses may be suspended. Eucharistic services are NOT TO BE CONDUCTED on these occasions; the faithful are to be provided with nearby parish Mass schedules so that they may participate in Mass.

This decree takes effect on July 1, 2023.
